QFRC Partnerships

We work in close partnership with all families and caregivers, kinship placement, grandparents raising grandchildren, LGBTQ+, behavioral health care providers, pediatric offices and other medical providers, schools, the juvenile court system, and DCF among others.

All services at the QFRC are free of charge and insurance is not needed.

Services We Offer

Assessment and Family Support Planning

- Conducted by a Licensed Clinician and our Family Partner
- Review areas of need and build a Family Support Plan based on recommendations and family input

Resources and Referrals

- Connect families in need with community based, behavioral health services within their own community
- Assist families & providers in identifying community resources & services that would best meet the specific needs of each family (assistance can be provided in-person or virtually, and by appointment or walk-in)

Groups and Events

- Caregiver & youth groups to address specific concerns such as school refusal, positive decision making, behavioral health, exploitation of children, etc.
- Caregiver Education & Support groups such as: Parenting Education, Grandparents Raising Grandchildren, Raising LGBTQ+ Youth (child supervision and food are provided during caregiver groups free of charge)
- Youth Support, Social, & Activity groups such as: LGBTQ+ Teens, Life Skills, Wellness
- Community Outreach programs & social events throughout the year
